The request is for staffing, and such supplies and equipment needed (not able to be supplied by the hospitals) to support up to 20 patients on a daily basis within the confines of existing hospital space. This request would support each hospital system (Cox Health-South and Mercy) at each of their two facilities. Wrap-around services consistent with typical hospital settings should be available. It is anticipated, but not fully confirmed that each hospital could supply up to 10 beds each for this mission.
