## Detailed description

\*This is a whole-community request supporting hospital decompression of non-critical patients pending long-term care placement back in the community. Nursing home and long-term care facilities will not receive residents back from the hospital until after their 21st day post initial onset of COVID symptoms. These are patients that do not have a medical need requiring them to stay as an in-patient in the hospital. The request is for staffing, supplies and equipment to support up to 25 patients on a daily basis. This alternate care site would support these non-critical convalescing patients ranging from ambulatory to potentially full-assist (skilled care or nursing home type patients).

### Detailed Description:

This is a whole-community request supporting hospital decompression of non-critical patients pending long-term care placement back in the community. Nursing home and long-term care facilities will not receive residents back from the hospital until after their 21st day post initial onset of COVID symptoms. These are patients that do not have a medical need requiring them to stay as an in-patient in the hospital. The request is for staffing, and such supplies and equipment needed (not able to be supplied by the hospitals) to support up to 20 patients on a daily basis within the confines of existing hospital space. This request would support each hospital system (Cox Health-South and Mercy) at each of their two facilities. Wrap-around services consistent with typical hospital settings should be available. It is anticipated, but not fully confirmed that each hospital could supply up to 10 beds each for this mission.

Should a stand-alone ACS be requested in the future, the following two sites are optimal:

Q Hotel and Suites (this property is managed by University Plaza Hotel 417-263-1040), 1117 E. St. Louis, Springfield: this hotel is currently vacant and could be occupied immediately  
Kentwood Hall, MSU Campus, 73 rooms on three floors with 101 beds, each dorm type room has private bath with tub/shower or walk-in shower and beds.
